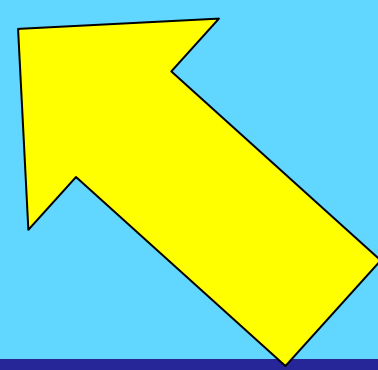

- **National Contact Points (NCPs)** are national structures established and financed by governments of the Member States and the states associated to the Framework Programme
- NCPs provide highly professional support services operating nationally which form an essential component of Horizon 2020 implementation. NCPs spread awareness, give specialist advice, and provide on-the-ground guidance for the stakeholders.
- NCPs exist in 28 EU Member States.
- 239 NCPs are nominated in the third countries
